## I HEARD ABOUT CHILDREN'S BIBLE CLUBS FROM KEVIN AND SAM. WHAT ARE THEY LIKE?

If you like to sing songs, memorize Bible verses, and meet good friends, you'd have a great time at a Children's Bible Club! There are two kinds, but they have a lot in common. Most importantly, they both share Bible stories and teach the boys and girls how to pray. This is a big deal, because many kids in India have never heard a single Bible story and have no idea that they can pray to Jesus!



Have you gone to Vacation Bible School before? They're usually filled with skits, songs, and Bible stories, and are a lot like the first kind of Bible Club: **10-Day Children's Bible Clubs**. These happen in the summer, all day, for 10 days. Since kids aren't in school, it's the perfect chance to share the love of Jesus while giving them a fun place to spend part of their summer.



Can you imagine living in a neighborhood where no one had ever heard of Jesus? 10-Day Bible Clubs are a great way to introduce places like these to Him. When 10-Day Bible Clubs finish up, parents and other neighbors are welcome to come see what the kids have learned, and they hear about Jesus there—many for the first time!

The other kind of Bible Club is a **Year-Long Children's Bible Club**. These start at the beginning of each school year and run for a couple of hours after school each day. Year-Long Bible Clubs take time each day to play sports and games, so kids can't wait to join and make new friends as they play!



One of the main differences between Year-Long and 10-Day Bible Clubs is the homework help offered. Many kids' parents have no education, so they can't help their sons and daughters with homework. When they hear that Year-Long Bible Clubs offer free tutoring, they're eager to sign their kids up—even if they don't believe in Jesus yet.
